& help fight illiteracy and poverty





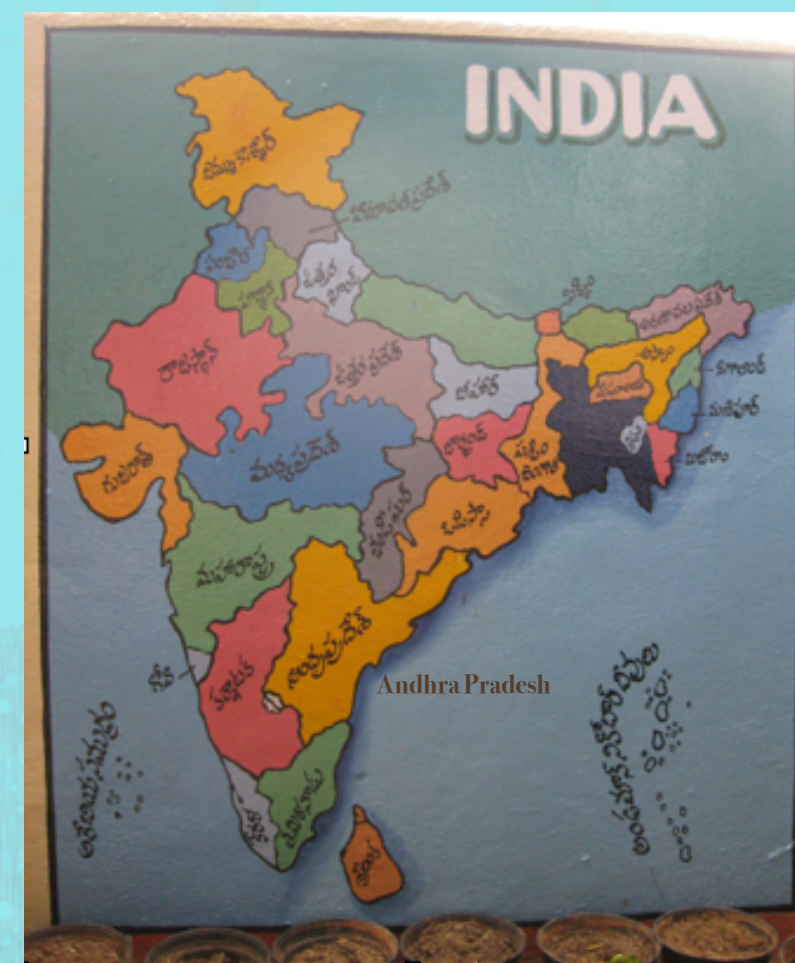
